LENT

Lent our 40-day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving begins next Wednesday, 18th. It's a time of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries and extras during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. **Masses and distribution of blessed ashes will be at 7.30am, 10.00am and 7.30pm in the Parish Church and 8.00pm in Clonaghadoo.**

DURING LENT JOIN US

TUESDAY Morning Mass: Beginning on Tuesday February 24th and continuing then on each Tuesday morning of Lent there will be a 7.30am mass in our Parish Church.

Stations of the Cross for Lent: All are welcome each Sunday evening during Lent (beginning Sun 22nd) at 7.00pm to the Parish Church for a praying of The Stations of the Cross.

After the 10am mass on the Fridays of Lent (beginning Fri 20th) there will be a short praying of the 'Stations of the Cross' for those who are available to join in.
