In the First Reading, the prophet Isaiah tells how God will prepare a banquet of rich food for all peoples. God will remove their sadness so that all will rejoice in the saving hand of God. The Gospel from St. Matthew offers us yet another parable of the Kingdom. The 'great' banquet is offered to all, Jews and Gentiles – though some refuse and are rejected. All of us, good and bad alike, have only to respond to the invitation. The wedding feast is not just a heavenly banquet: the Reign of God is in the here and now.
