CHRISTMAS and KEEPING SAFE



The schedule for Christmas Masses is as follows:

St. Joseph's Parish Church
Christmas Eve 7.00pm, 9.00pm and 11.00pm
Christmas Morning 8.00am, 10.00am and 12noon.

St. Mary's Clonaghadoo Christmas Eve 9.00pm Christmas Morning 10.00am.



As already mentioned, our capacity in both churches is extremely limited so in the interests of public health and to try and manage our numbers safely a ticketing system will apply. There will be three types of tickets: (1) a family ticket for up to five or six people from the same household (2) a single ticket for an individual person and (3) a double ticket for two people for example a husband and wife, a brother and sister, a parent and child, from the same household.

The family groups will be seated in the available seats in both the left and right-hand side aisles. The double ticket and single ticket places will be divided between the available rows of the main aisle. This plan applies to both churches.

Tickets will be available from the Parish Office from next Wednesday morning. You may only collect tickets for your own family members <u>and not for anyone else</u>. We look forward to your cooperation in this regard. Those collecting tickets will be asked to sign for each of them and leave a contact number.

As we have a responsibility to observe all the Govt. restrictions and we want to facilitate as many as we can we would encourage families, for this year, to consider attending their "Christmas" mass on any of the 12 days of Christmas, which will be quieter and safer.

While these arrangements are very different from our normal Christmas this is not a normal year and the health and well-being of everyone must be our first consideration. With your cooperation we will respect that, celebrate our masses as safely as we can and together do our best to prevent any further spread of the virus.
