Heart Soul

Believers united, heart and soul!

This Sunday, like the first believers, we are praying for unity of heart and soul. With our fellow Christians, we celebrate the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, the Lord of Life! The Gospel reading (Jn 20:19-31) combines two scenes: Jesus' appearance to his disciples after his Resurrection and his chat with Thomas, the disciple who doubted. The disciples receive through Jesus the gift of the Holy Spirit and are given their mission. A week later, the Lord appears again

to the previously absent Thomas, eliciting his magnificent confession: 'My Lord and my God'! Thomas gives witness to us that the Jesus who was raised is the same Jesus who died. Through the gift of the Holy Spirit, we are among those who are blessed, for we have not seen and yet believe. Alleluia.

This is an excerpt from St. Faustina's "Prayer to be Merciful." Saint Bernadette Soubirous - Feast Day April 16th

Bernadette Soubirous was born in 1844, the first child of an extremely poor miller in the town of Lourdes in southern France. In February 1858, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to Bernadette in a cave above the banks of the Gave River near Lourdes. The 'Lady', Bernadette explained, had instructed her to have a chapel built on the spot of the visions. In the vision on March 25, she told

Millions of people have visited Lourdes to pray at the grotto where Bernadette saw Mary. They go to open their hearts to God, as Mary and Bernadette had. Bernadette died on April 16, 1879, at the age of 35 and was canonized by Pope Pius XI on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception 1933. St. Bernadette, pray for us.
