PENTECOST: The Spirit of truth will lead you to the complete truth. Today we celebrate the great day of Pentecost, when

Christ filled the Church with the power of his Spirit and sent his followers out into the world to bring his peace, joy and mercy to all. The First Reading tells the story of what happened on the first Pentecost. With the advent of the Holy

#### STATEMENT FROM BISHOP NULTY REGARDING CELEBRATION OF SACRAMENTS.

On Wednesday last, 19th May,

Archbishop Dermot Farrell, Dublin, was communicating with the Office of the Taoiseach seeking further clarification, and guidance, on the Celebration of Sacraments at this time. The subsequent advice that was issued from the Office of the Taoiseach, was "it is advised that other religious ceremonies such as First Holy Communions and Confirmations should not take place in May and June Further advice

Confirmations should not take place in May and June. Further advice will follow on resumption of these ceremonies when it is safe to do so". It is with sadness then that I request that there be no celebration of the Sacraments of First Holy Communion or Confirmation in Kildare & Leighlin in these months.

We must continue to adhere to advice not even, but especially, as we emerge, hopefully, from this pandemic. With continued prayers, Bishop Denis Nulty, Bishop of Kildare & Leighlin. *May 21st, 2021*
