'I am the bread of life'



Our readings today demonstrate how God draws us close and – through Jesus Christ – nourishes and sustains us with the living bread of the Eucharist. In the Gospel, those hostile to Jesus

are complaining against him, confused by and misunderstanding his teachings. But Jesus challenges their criticism directly: he is the one who has come to reveal the Father to them. Jesus teaches that he himself is the true, living bread from heaven; bread that gives life for ever. We pray this week for an openness to the Lord's tender, nourishing care, especially when we experience times of alienation, selfdoubt or despair. We pray to deepen our acknowledgment of our human vulnerability, and our utter dependence on God's grace and love. "The bread I shall give is my flesh for the life of the world", says the Lord. (*Communion Antiphon*)

Father Maximilian Kolbe Feast Day Sat August 14

During the Second World War, Fr. Maximilian Kolbe gave shelter to thousands of Polish people, both Christians and Jews. He risked his life to help these suffering people. In 1941 Fr. Kolbe was sent as a prisoner to a concentration camp given a striped convict's uniform and the number 16670. One day a prisoner escaped from the camp. To punish the rest of the prisoners, the officers said 10 men would be killed. These men would be dropped into a pit and left to slowly and painfully starve to death. The guards chose the 10 men. As the men were gathered, one cried out, "My wife, my children! I shall never see them again!" From the watching crowd, another prisoner stepped forward. "I will take his place," he said. It was Father Kolbe, prisoner 16670. He was canonized in October 1982. Pope St. John Paul II said of Father Kolbe, "He won a victory of love. He loved both his fellow prisoners and those who put him to death. There is no greater love than this."
