
Tuesday Aug 17th Feast of Our Lady of Knock

Sr. Monica (Mona) Hayes was born on August 8th 1921 in Irishtown, Mountmellick, the youngest child of the late Patrick and Brigid Hayes and sister to the late Ita, John and Jimmy. She was educated by the local Presentation Sisters at both primary and secondary levels and then entered the Franciscan Missionary Sisters at their noviciate in Bloomfield, Mullingar. In 1940 Sr. Monica travelled to Rome for her first Profession and later that year to U.S.A. where she still lives. Over the years Sr. Monica returned home regularly to Mountmellick and still reminisces about her youth and retains a great interest in her home town. On August 8th Sr. Monica celebrated a very happy 100th birthday with her Franciscan sisters. Congratulations Sr. Monica, keep well.
