Oct 15th - Feast of St. Teresa of Avila

St. Teresa of Ávila, the founder of the Discalced Carmelites, which was a reform movement within the Carmelite Order was born in Avila, Spain on March 28th 1515. In her work of reform she taught her nuns to think and pray on their own, and to concentrate in order to hear the Lord in their interior, in what she called the "Interior Castle." St. Teresa was made a Doctor of the Church in 1970, together with St. Catherine of Sienna, the first women to be given this title, now shared by St. Thérèse of Lisieux, another Carmelite whose feast was celebrated on October 1st.
