**Pope Francis 2022 Peace  
Message: - spend more on  
education, less on weapons.**

Pope Francis urged global leaders to spend more money on education and devote fewer resources to weapons in his 2022 World Day of Peace message. "It is high time, then, that governments develop economic policies aimed at inverting the proportion of public funds spent on education and on weaponry." In his introduction to the three-page text, the pope laments that despite numerous efforts aimed at fostering the conditions for peace, "the deafening noise of war and conflict is intensifying." In concluding his peace message, Pope Francis acknowledges the many ways in which the Covid -19 pandemic has disrupted human relationships, economic opportunities, and exacerbated inequalities. Church and world leaders alike, along with all people of goodwill, he pleads, must "walk together with courage and creativity on the path of intergenerational dialogue, education and work." (NCR)


The 2022 Parish Calendar will be available next weekend to pick up at the back of the churches.
