'Do whatever he tells you.'



In the First Reading today Isaiah uses the imagery of a wedding to describe the ways in which the deep love of God for his people will transform our lives. God delights in us: 'As the bridegroom rejoices in his bride so will your God rejoice in you'. Another wedding

scene is described in today's Gospel. At the beginning of his public life, Jesus's love and care transform a wedding feast from disaster to joyous celebration by turning water into wine. In what ways do we need the Lord to transform our lives this week?

In what was another difficult year for couples planning their wedding day we had 11 couples who managed their way through all the protocols and restrictions and celebrated with family and friends. We keep all of them in our prayers today and all those who continue to look forward and plan for 2022 and beyond.

Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2022

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity will begin on Tuesday next, 18 January, and last until 25 January. The theme this year is "We saw the star in the East, and we come to worship him" (Mt 2:2). The resources for this year were compiled in Lebanon and reflect the civil conflict and experiences of the people there; a yearning for a light leading to the Saviour who overcomes darkness.

"Gracious God, when we only know one way and we think we must return to it, when we think that all roads are blocked, and we fall into despair, we always find you there, creating a new unexpected path before us. If we search our maps and find no route, nonetheless we always find you, who lead us by a yet more excellent way, trusting that you will always lead us back to you and forward in unity together. Amen".
