CONTINUING OUR RECOVERY



This week's readings focus on the need for prayer and trust in the 2010, when we feel isolated and despondent. of God To this end, the first reading tells the story of Moses, who is helped by his friends to continue brandishing the 'staff of God'

even when he is too tired to raise his arms. Together they help to contribute to the victory against Israel's enemies, the Amalekites. The Gospel reading, sometimes called the 'Parable of the Persistent Widow', or of the 'Unjust Judge', reflects on the need to pray continually. We are to persist in our petitions, even if at first the Lord appears deaf to our pleading. This week then we persist in our entreaties, perhaps with the help of friends, trusting that the Lord will guard us from evil. "Our help is in the name of the Lord who made heaven and earth".

World Mission Sunday 23rd October 2022

World Mission Sunday (You will be my Witnesses) is the Pope's annual appeal for spiritual and financial support so that the life-giving work of overseas mission and missionaries can continue. It always falls on the second last Sunday in October, meaning this year it will be celebrated next weekend. All offerings made on behalf of World Mission Sunday become part of the Pope's Universal Solidarity Fund that supports missionary activities in over 1,100 young dioceses, mostly in Africa, Asia, and Latin America. As young dioceses grow, so do their needs. On top of this, they are often found in remote areas devastated by conflict or natural disasters. FEASTDAYS: On Tuesday Oct 18 we celebrate the feast day of St. Luke. We know him best as the author of the third gospel and of the Acts of the Apostles. His books reveal something about his character and some of his main themes prayer, the Holy Spirit, and mercy - suggest that he was a compassionate, spiritual man. Karol Józef Wojtyla, known as John Paul II since his October 1978 election to the papacy, was born near Kraków, on May 18, 1920. Throughout his pontificate he completed more than 200 pastoral visits – including one to Ireland in 1979 to honour the centenary of the apparitions at Knock Shrine. He died in April 2005 and was canonized along with Pope John 23rd in April 2014. His feastday is Saturday next, Oct 22nd.
