

Maybe I can spend time offering God my brokenness and relying on his mercy. I speak to the Lord, allowing him to see my whole truth. I may wish to give thanks for the witness of many humble people who may or may not be recognised in this world. I remember those burdened by guilt, and place them in the hands of Jesus, friend of sinners. Perhaps I also wish to pray that I may not add to division between people. I humbly end my prayer: 'God, be merciful to me, a sinner'.
