# A Voice Cries in the Wilderness, 'Prepare A Way for the Lord'

As we take another step into Advent, this week's Gospel text highlights John the Baptist at the River Jordan entreating people 'to repent and prepare a way' for the one who is to come. 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand'. He tells them that being a son or daughter of Abraham will not be enough to be sure of being saved. There is no room for complacency. People are to repent; to change their way of life. In the 1<sup>st</sup> reading we are introduced to one of the main themes of this period of the year: Peace. Isaiah paints a picture of the whole world, of people and animals living together in harmony, led by a King who has all the qualities to rule justly.
