THEY ARE HAPPY WHO FOLLOW GOD'S LAW

Today's readings are all concerned with the law and commandments of Moses. They reflect on the happiness which can be ours if we keep to the spirit of the law and not just its letter. In the 1st reading the author stresses that we are given absolute freedom to choose to keep the commandments or not. In the Gospel, we hear Jesus telling his disciples that he has come to complete the law, not to abolish it. He is the fulfilment of the law. Using a few everyday examples, he shows how we need to go beyond the letter of the commandments and truly understand what is behind them. This week, we might pray for all law makers, in the Church and in Government, that they always work for the greater good of all.
