A VOICE THAT SPEAKS OF PEACE

Our readings this week reiterate the need to listen to God's voice in all the circumstances of our lives, especially in times of trial. Thereby we might become artisans of peace in our world. In the 1st Reading, God appears to a despondent Elijah

in the voice of a gentle breeze, and the prophet gains courage to face his mission. The disciples are also disheartened (Gospel Mt 14:22–33), and slow to recognize the Lord in the midst of the storm. They worship him as he reaches out to save them. May we remind ourselves this week that Christ, our peace, is always with us, and with our world, amidst the storms and difficulties of our lives.

This significant feast day recalls the spiritual and physical departure of the mother of Jesus Christ from the earth, when both her soul and her body were taken into the presence of God. Pope Pius 12th confirmed this belief about the Virgin Mary when he defined it formally as a dogma of our faith in 1950, proclaiming, "that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory."
