In today's Gospel (Mt 17:1-9) the account of the Transfiguration occurs as Jesus is about to make his final journey to Jerusalem and to the Cross. His imminent tragedy is seen through a vision of the glory that is to come. For us, who carry our own tragedies and crosses, there is help in these readings. They hint at our own glory, too, as God's adopted people, redeemed and sanctified. This week let's pray that, despite our own personal struggles and the darkness of the world's news, we might hold onto the hope of the glory that is ours through a share in Christ's everlasting life.

Prayer for Fine Weather


All-powerful and ever-living God, We find security in your care and love for us.
