

# Kildare & Leighlin Diocese at the Ploughing Championships Block 2: Row 20: Stand 326

'Ploughing a Prayerful Path' & asking 'Who is Your Favourite Saint?' Visitors to Stand 326 at the National Ploughing Championships will be asked to name their favourite saint, invited to help re-create St. Brigid's Cloak and they will also see the traditional St. Brigid's crosses being made. The very popular packets of blessed salt will be available once again. The salt can then be spread on gardens and farms – a traditional practice in many areas of the country. Those who would like a few moments away from the hustle of the crowds can join a meditation session or a period of quiet reflection in a special Prayer Space, pin their intentions on the Prayer Wall or enjoy a cup of tea/coffee, a biscuit and a chat. There will also be live music with some well-known singers and groups dropping in to share their talent. The votes for Ireland's favourite saint will be counted and the result revealed on day three.
