The greatest one among you must be your servant.

We are called today to honour God in humility, sincerity and truth. In the First Reading, the prophet Malachi doesn't mince his words. His message is hardhitting: the priests are reproached for their spiritual negligence and failure to instruct the people properly, as well as for their half-hearted service of God. Religious leaders are also criticised in the Gospel. Jesus castigates their hypocrisy: they are more concerned with drawing attention to themselves and

exploiting their social position, rather than committing themselves to the message they preach. This type of self-aggrandisement and pride is the exact opposite of what the followers of Jesus should aspire to. Jesus himself is our role model: he teaches us that the route to leadership is through service of God in all things. To follow Christ is to serve him humbly; and humility, together with complete trust in God, is the theme of today's Psalm.


