### **Brigid 1500 Service to be Celebrated by Churches Together**

On Thursday next, 1st February 2024, churches across Kildare and beyond will come together to participate in a special ecumenical service at 11.00am in St Brigid's Cathedral, Kildare entitled, 'Celebrating St Brigid. Brigid 1500: A Service of Thanksgiving'. This service is dedicated to commemorating the 1500th anniversary of St Brigid's death and will take place on her Feast Day, Lá Fhéile Bríde. It promises an

uplifting experience through music, prayer, and worship. Livestreaming of the service will be available worldwide. The co-leaders of this thanksgiving service are the Most Rev Denis Nulty, Roman Catholic Bishop of Kildare and Leighlin, and the Most Rev. Patricia Storey, Church of Ireland Bishop of Meath and Kildare. The Rev. Canon Dr. Alison Joyce, the Rector of St. Bride's Church, Fleet Street, in the heart of London, will deliver the sermon. The service will also feature the leaders of the three local churches in Kildare town, Dean Isobel Jackson (St Brigid's Cathedral, Kildare), Fr. Andy Leahy, PP, (St Brigid's Parish Church) and Fr. T.C. Antony (Carmelite Church). St. Brigid's Cathedral, Kildare marks the ancient hilltop site where St. Brigid founded her double monastery, for men and for women, in the year 480 AD. At the end of the service, a Pause for Peace will be observed in the cathedral at 12 noon. It will be introduced by Sr. Rita Minehan from the Brigidine Sisters. Aligning with a broader initiative whereby the people of Kildare are extending a global invitation, urging individuals worldwide to pause for a minute's silence at midday (local time) on St Brigid's Day.

### Carlow Cathedral Evening Prayer for St Brigid, 7.30pm, Feb 1st.

February 1st marks the opening of a national year commemorating St. Brigid, patron of our diocese and secondary patron of Ireland, 1500 years since her death. Bishop Denis invites people across the diocese to join him for a special evening prayer in the Cathedral of the Assumption on February 1st at 7:30 pm.

Music will be led by Fr. Liam Lawton and the diocesan choir. **All welcome.**
