THE GOOD NEWS OF THE COVENANT

We began our Lenten journey on Wednesday. This first Sunday of Lent now leads us immediately into Jesus's own journey into the desert in prayer, fasting, and to face temptation. In the 1st reading we are reminded of the journey of God's chosen people. Here God establishes a Covenant with Noah

and all his descendants, and with the whole of creation. Never again will God destroy the earth with a flood. He leaves a bow in the sky to confirm this. The Gospel gives us a short account of Jesus being tempted in the desert. He emerges ready to proclaim his message: 'The kingdom of God is close at hand'. May we take heart from the scriptures as we begin our Lenten journey, ready to follow the Lord's ways, and eager to learn his paths.
