## GIVING SUNDAY - March 24<sup>th</sup> 2015/2025 DEBT CAMPAIGN

Dear Parishioners,

It's that time of the year again when I invite your kind support for our 'Debt Campaign' fundraising. Our annual 'Giving Sunday' fundraiser will take place on March 24th. Last year a total of €25,500 was donated on Giving Sunday. Revenue's Charitable Donation Scheme allows tax relief on qualifying donations. Thus far for us it has realised €33,000. Many thanks to all.

In addition to ongoing expenses, in the past year €25,000 was spent on cleaning, repairing, sealing and painting all the gutters, €7,500 on new lights in and around the sanctuary area of St. Joseph's Church and a contribution of €7,350 towards the resurfacing of the Arts Centre Car Park.

'Giving Sunday' asks you, as your means will allow, to make a special significant contribution once a year to help pay off our debt. Thank you for your support. Micheal Murphy, PP.

Parish accounts summary for 2023 as approved by the Diocesan Accountant. Total Income: Basket and Envelope Collections, Shrines, Bingo, Fundraising, Bequests, Trócaire, Peters Pence, Lotto, etc - €315,077. Parish Operating Expenses: Salaries, Insurance, Repairs & Maintenance, Heating, Altar/Shrine Requisites, Lighting, IT, Stationery, Printing etc - €272,751. Due to accounting protocols, we are obliged to include all collections (Trócaire, Retired Priests etc) as both income and expenditure.

The full Parish Accounts Report for 2023 is available in the Parish Office.

Tax Relief from Revenue. The Parish as a registered charity is eligible to claim tax relief from Revenue (Charitable Donation Scheme) on the donations made by any individual during the tax year providing such donations amount to €250 or more. If you paid income tax in any or all of the last four years ('20 to '23) and donated more than a total of €250 to the parish whether in the collections at mass, weekly envelopes, bequests, once off contributions, Giving Sunday, etc by cash, cheque or otherwise in each of those years then we can claim a refund from Revenue at no cost of any kind to you. To help us we need you to fill out the CHY3 Form. These forms are available in the Parish Office. Many thanks.
