Message from Pope Francis for World Day of Prayer for Vocations -'pilgrims of hope and builders of peace'.

Dear brothers and sisters,

Each year, the World Day of Prayer for Vocations invites us to reflect on the precious gift of the Lord's call to each of us, as members of his faithful pilgrim people, to participate in his loving plan and to embody the beauty of the Gospel in different states of life..... To young people, I want to say this: Let Jesus draw you to himself; bring him your important questions by reading the Gospels; let him challenge you by his presence, which always provokes in us a healthy crisis. More than anyone else, Jesus respects our freedom. He does not impose, but proposes. Make room for him and you will find the way to happiness by following him. And, should he ask it of you, by giving yourself completely to him...... Let us awaken from sleep, let us leave indifference behind, let us open the doors of the prison in which we so often enclose ourselves, so that each of us can discover his or her proper vocation in the Church and in the world, and become a pilgrim of hope and a builder of peace! (*Rome, Saint John Lateran, 21 April 2024, Fourth Sunday of Easter*).

World Day of Prayer for Vocations is also known as 'Good Shepherd Sunday' because the Gospel is always from John chapter 10 where Jesus speaks of himself as being a caring shepherd. The purpose of this day is to publicly fulfil the Lord's instruction when he asked us: 'Pray the Lord of the harvest to send labourers into his harvest'. (*Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2*). Please pray that many men and women hear and respond generously to the Lord's call to the priesthood and religious life and that the Church will always have many who care for God's people with the heart of Christ himself.
