Go out to the whole world.

"He was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight" (1st Reading). At first glance, it appears that the movement is vertical, up in the clouds. Lost is this scene, however, to modern readership. Ancient peoples of many cultures understood that an anointed person, someone touched by the divine hand of God, had a secure place in the next world; for them, eternity was guaranteed. Luke

relates Jesus' ascension as a way of illustrating his movement from the mortal to eternal realms. Luke considers it a distraction to linger too long on this ascension event, however. The real "movement" in Luke's ascension narrative is the work of the disciples. As they look up, wideeyed with mouths open, an angel speaks to them, "Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky?". The disciples have had their 'moment'of transition, their sacred time. It is now time to get to work; they must move!

'Hope' is the central message of Pope Francis' decree for Jubilee Year 2025.

On Thursday Pope Francis published his decree for the Jubilee Year 2025, which he will open in St. Peter's Basilica on Dec. 24, 2024, and close on Jan. 6, 2026. Hope is the central message of the decree, known

by its Latin title "Spes non Confundit" ("Hope does not disappoint"). Pope Francis told believers that in this Jubilee Year "we are called to be tangible signs of hope for those of our brothers and sisters who experience hardship of any kind." He emphasized the need for diplomacy to resolve the wars and armed conflicts around the world, called on leaders to address the needs of "the billions" of poor people in the world who lack food and water.
