# REMEMBERING POPE FRANCIS

Pope Francis was born Jorge Mario Bergoglio on December 17, 1936, in Buenos Aires, Argentina. He felt the call of God and was ordained a Jesuit priest on December 13, 1969. He was elected pope on March 13, 2013. In Rome, Pope Francis, or Francisco, was known as il Papa, which means Father. The pope is the Bishop of Rome and the leader of the worldwide Catholic

Church. In his time as pope, Francis shared a vision of Church that emphasizes hope, mercy, and care for each other. Pope Francis was the first Jesuit pope. He entered eternal life on Monday last, April 21, 2025.

We entrust Pope Francis to God's mercy and continue to pray for the Church as she prepares to elect a new Successor of St. Peter: Heavenly God, we commend to Your mercy our Holy Father, Pope Francis. May he enter into the eternal joy prepared for those who love You. Through Christ our Lord.
