The Lord is kind and full of compassion, slow to anger, abounding in mercy. How good is the Lord to all, compassionate to all his creatures (*Psalm 144*). As this year's season of Easter draws to a close, we are guided to remain focused on Jesus's central commandment to his followers: 'Love'. We are loved, forgiven and transformed sinners; called, commanded and commissioned to love others; graced and grounded in the love that has been poured out for us. This love inspired the Early Church to spread the Good News of Jesus's life, death and resurrection throughout Asia Minor (present-day Turkey and Syria). Paul and Barnabas supported and appointed leaders to keep the flame of God's love alive in these early church communities. Today's Gospel proclaims a simple, joyful central message. Jesus gives his followers, gives us, a 'new commandment': 'Love one another, as I have loved you.' We pray in this Jubilee Year that we will be inspired to care for each other and for all creation with compassion and love, strengthened by Jesus's love for us.
