JESUS OUR GUEST. This week's readings highlight the qualities that help nourish our relationship with God and with one another: openness, hospitality and joy. In the first reading Abraham recognises God in the three who appear at the door of his tent. He eagerly invites God to be a dinner quest with him and his wife, Sarah, as they set about preparing a fine feast. The passage reminds us to respond to God's constant invitation to welcome him into our lives through the various people we encounter, so that we may receive the many blessings he has to offer. In the Gospel, Jesus visits his good friends, Martha and Mary. Jesus gently encourages Martha to be more present in the moment, not allowing her endless 'to do' list to keep her from developing her relationship with God and with others. Today we pray that we will truly see and be open to receiving God in every living moment. We ask that our everyday decisions and behaviour are always guided by the desire to draw closer to God.

REEK SUNDAY: All welcome to celebrate 'Hope' on Ireland's holy mountain of Croagh Patrick. Next Sunday is 'Reek Sunday' and thousands of pilgrims of all ages are expected to scale Ireland's 'Holy Mountain', Croagh Patrick. The theme of Reek Sunday 2025 is 'Christian Hope', and this annual pilgrimage will continue the 1,600 year-old tradition of people scaling Croagh Patrick to gather as a community of faith, to pray and participate in the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession), and the Sacrament of the Eucharist (Mass) at the summit.

St Columbanus' Vision and Legacy Celebrated in Kildare and Leighlin.

Pope Leo sent his "heartfelt good wishes" to Bishop Nulty and all participants taking part in last week's 'XXVI Columbanus Weekend'. In a message from Cardinal Pietro Parolin, Secretary of State on behalf of the Pontiff, Pope Leo said: "In a particular way St Columban, speaking across the centuries, can still teach our world today about how love for God and neighbour requires us to care for creation and to cultivate our souls in the theological virtues, for every aspect of our world reflects in some way the grandeur and goodness of its divine maker." Following the successful conclusion of the event, which drew pilgrims from Italy, France, Switzerland and Austria as well as from the across the island of Ireland, Bishop Nulty wrote: "Columbanus should be embraced today as the saint who can bring us back to the sacredness of creation and humanity".
