Jubilee Year of Hope - Parish Pilgrimage to Knock.

In May 2024, the late Pope Francis announced a 'Jubilee Year' for 2025 with $\mathcal{L}_{s}^{\tilde{s}}$ the theme "Hope does not disappoint" encouraging each of us to be messengers of hope and pilgrims of hope in our very troubled world. A characteristic of a Holy/Jubilee Year – a plenary indulgence – has also been declared for specific jubilee pilgrimages. The Irish Bishops have designated that pilgrimages to Our Lady's Shrine, in Knock fall into this category. We will have a parish pilgrimage to Knock for the feast of Our Blessed Lady's Birthday, Monday Sept. 8th. THE WORD OF GOD: This Sunday's scriptures asks three things of us: to make prudent use of the gifts given us; to keep our focus on the true riches that are to come rather than on the transitory wealth of this earthly life; and so, to want and to choose whatever leads to God's life deepening in us.
